



Study Mode and Course Pre-Registration for October 2020 Trimester

28 August 2020

UTAR has previously announced on 11 August 2020 that the University campuses in Sungai Long and Kampar will be open from October 2020 Trimester onwards. Subject to the latest MOHE instructions, professional body requirements, and the safety and health Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) required by the Government; students are advised to evaluate the ongoing COVID-19 situation, learning environment and course requirements when choosing their study mode of classes during course pre-registration. The university would also like to thank all students who have participated in the recent online survey on your planned study mode and courses to be taken in the October 2020 Trimester. Your feedback in this survey is very much appreciated.

With reference to the above, the University would like to update all students on the following in preparation for the October 2020 Trimester:

- (i) All students (including new intake students) of Foundation and Undergraduate Programmes are required to log on to the course pre-registration system (<https://unitreg.utar.edu.my/>) to complete the confirmation of study mode. In addition, all students (except for new intake students) shall proceed to perform the regular course pre-registration for the October 2020 Trimester as per previous trimesters.
- (ii) Remote Examination including Continuous Assessments (i.e. tests and assignments) and Final Assessments (i.e. time-restricted open-ended assessments and online examinations) will be implemented for the October 2020 Trimester.

In general, to fulfill proper physical distancing requirements, the **blended learning** mode will be conducted in the October 2020 Trimester where **all lectures** will be conducted through **OTL** (Online Teaching and Learning). However, **tutorials / practical sessions** will be conducted primarily via **physical mode** for students who choose to return to campus; and via **OTL mode** for students who choose to study remotely from home. For certain courses, tutorials / practical classes are conducted via both physical and OTL mode **concurrently**. For details of the courses, please refer to your respective faculty / Centre for Foundation Studies.

1. Students who have registered for courses with compulsory physical classes as listed in **Table 1** (the same list as announced on 11 August 2020) shall return to campus physically. The courses listed in **Table 1** require essential physical sessions including lectures / tutorials / hands-on laboratory / practical training / clinical work as per programme / course requirements

by the faculty or professional bodies; and students taking these courses are required to return to campus to conduct these activities for the October 2020 Trimester. However, students who are **NOT** able to return to campus to carry out such essential physical hands-on classes / activities due to unavoidable reasons, must apply to your respective faculty Dean with the appropriate reason(s) for approval to fulfil this requirement at a later time. Please contact your respective Dean for more information if you need further clarification regarding this requirement.

2. **All other students** are given an option to:

EITHER

(a) Study remotely from home via OTL mode only (**NOT** return to campus),

OR

(b) Return to campus to resume face-to-face teaching and learning, group work and student activities via physical / OTL mode.

(a) Students who opt for 100% Online Teaching and Learning (OTL) and hence, choose NOT to return to campus physically for the entire October 2020 Trimester must apply to your respective Dean / Director for approval through the online course pre-registration system. Please ensure that all your registered courses require solely the **OTL** mode and do not have any compulsory physical tutorials or practical sessions required by the professional body or faculty (refer to **Table 1**). After checking, do proceed to do the course pre-registration as in usual trimesters to select **tutorials / practical groups** via OTL mode.

(b) Students who choose to return to campus physically must indicate this decision through the course pre-registration system and proceed to do the course pre-registration as in usual trimesters to opt for **tutorials / practical sessions** via physical or OTL mode. Please be reminded to ensure own safety during and upon returning to campus. Students must adhere to the University SOPs, safety and health precautionary measures, including temperature screening at entrance, wearing of masks at all times, the use of sanitizers, maintaining physical distancing and limiting the number of students in any one location as per MOHE / MOH directives. Please also cross check your registered courses with the list of courses in **Table 2** which are fully conducted online (i.e. without any physical tutorials and practical classes). If you only take those courses listed in **Table 2**, then you should opt for OTL mode since you need not return to campus physically for these courses.

3. **For students who return to campus**, you can utilize venues and infrastructures within both Sungai Long Campus and Kampar Campus, made available during week days (except for Saturday / Sunday / Public Holidays) during the change-over between classes conducted via physical and OTL mode as listed in **Table 3**. The specially allocated learning spaces (including the libraries) are equipped with proper seating arrangements / wifi access for you to use your own device to attend classes via OTL mode at your convenience during the October 2020 Trimester.

4. **Students who have registered for industrial training** in the October 2020 Trimester and who will be attached to a company outside the University need **NOT** return to campus. Please follow the instructions of your faculty for industrial training arrangements.

Online Course Pre-registration for the October 2020 Trimester

The Course Pre-registration for Foundation and Undergraduate Programmes conducted online via (<https://unitreg.utar.edu.my/>) shall begin in September 2020 according to the staggered schedule as follows:

- (i) **Foundation Programmes: 2 to 4 September 2020**
- (ii) **Undergraduate Programmes: 3 to 18 September 2020**

Please refer to **Table 4** for the details of the staggered timetable allocated to the programme of each faculty / centre for the October 2020 Trimester accordingly. A user guide video clip for reference on the online course pre-registration exercise is available at <http://shorturl.at/cjEQ1>. Please login using your UTAR email ID and password to access the video.

Please take note that each academic programme is given a specific time period to complete the following:

- i. Confirmation of Study Mode;** and / or
- ii. Course Pre-registration.**

If you have any query on the confirmation of study mode and / or course pre-registration, you may contact your respective faculty / centre general office for further clarification.

For confirmation of study mode, all students (including new intake students) must inform their decision to **(a) Study remotely from home (NOT return to campus) via OTL mode, OR (b) Return to campus** to resume face-to-face teaching and learning, group work and student activities via the **physical / OTL mode**. When you choose and submit 'Study remotely from home (NOT return to campus via OTL mode)', you are submitting online application of this study mode for the October 2020 Trimester to your respective faculty Dean / centre Director. Your application shall be auto-approved upon clicking the submission button.

For course pre-registration, students (except for new intake students) need to pre-register for courses to be taken in the October 2020 Trimester by choosing the lecture groups (via OTL mode only) and the appropriate tutorial / practical groups (via physical or OTL mode as in **(a)** or **(b)** above), as allotted by the respective faculty / centre for the registered courses, where applicable.

For new intake students, faculty / centre will pre-assign the lecture, tutorial / practical groups of all your registered courses. Please check your timetable on the student portal system for the details of assigned lecture / tutorial / practical groups and contact your faculty / centre general offices if you need further clarification.

Afterward, if you wish to change your decision on the study mode selected due to unforeseen reasons, you may contact your faculty / centre general office and apply to your faculty Dean or centre Director for their approval, before the commencement of the October 2020 Trimester. In addition, change of courses or lecture / tutorial / practical groups can be done through the Add / Drop Period of the October 2020 Trimester.

The conduct of all essential physical hands-on classes / activities in campus or the use of campus infrastructures and facilities, where relevant, will also follow all the health and safety,

as well as physical distancing procedures issued by the University and all the safety and health requirements as per MOHE and the relevant authorities.

Any changes / updates to the above arrangements will be announced from time to time, depending on the latest directives from MOHE, professional bodies and relevant authorities.
