



**Updates on Academic Study Mode and Course Pre-registration  
for May 2021 Trimester  
7 April 2021**

The University would like to inform all UTAR students of the following **updates and reminders** in preparation for the start of the May 2021 Trimester:

**A. Commencement of May 2021 Trimester**

1. The May 2021 Trimester for Foundation Programmes, Undergraduate Programmes and Postgraduate Programmes (coursework / mixed-mode) shall start on the dates as listed in the **Table A1** below:

**Table A1: Commencement Date of May 2021 Trimester for UTAR Programmes.**

2. Subject to the latest MOHE instructions and provided that physical classes can be conducted with physical distancing on campus, the **blended learning course delivery method** consisting of a combination of physical and OTL classes shall be conducted in May 2021 Trimester. Students will have the choice to return to campus for physical classes or continue to take OTL classes. **Table A2** shows a summary of course delivery methods as below:

**Table A2: Course Delivery Methods (OTL or Physical) according to Class Type.**

<b>Class Type</b>	<b>Course Delivery Method</b>
Lecture	OTL
Tutorial	Physical / OTL
Practical	Physical / OTL

- i. All **Lecture Classes** will be conducted via **OTL** mode.
- ii. **Tutorials / Practical Classes** will be conducted via **physical mode** for students who choose to return to campus; and via **OTL mode** for students who choose to study remotely.
- iii. **Remote Examination** including **Continuous Assessments** (i.e. tests and assignments) and **Final Assessments** (i.e. time-restricted open-ended assessments and online examinations) will

- be implemented for May 2021 Trimester. For courses in **Table A3**, physical Final Examination will be conducted.
- iv. For details of the courses, please refer to your respective Faculty / Institute / Centre.
  - v. All Foundation, Undergraduate, and Postgraduate students (including EEP) who wish to return to campus to use campus facilities, and meet with Academic Advisors, Project Supervisors and Course Lecturers, can arrange by appointment for face-to-face consultation in addition to online consultation. Physical distancing and safety SOPs must be strictly followed.
3. **Table A3** shows the **UPDATED LIST** of courses with **compulsory physical practical classes** required by the professional body or faculty where the students are required to return to campus. However, if you are NOT able to return to campus to carry out such essential physical hands-on classes / laboratory / practical training / clinical work / studio due to unavoidable reasons, you must apply to your respective Faculty Dean with the appropriate reason(s) for approval to fulfil this requirement at a later time. Please contact your respective Dean for more information if you need further clarification regarding this requirement.
  4. **Table A4** shows the **UPDATED LIST** of courses that are **100% fully conducted via OTL**. If ALL your registered courses for May 2021 Trimesters are conducted via OTL mode only, then you need not opt to “Return to campus” unless you wish to use the campus facilities.
  5. For courses offered in May 2021 Trimester but not listed in **Table A3** and **Table A4**, Faculty / Institute / Centre will arrange the tutorial / practical groups to be conducted in both **OTL mode** and **physical mode** (subjected to the availability of the capacity) according to the course planning, as mentioned in the item 2 above. Students will have the choice to choose for either the OTL group or the physical group provided, where relevant and available.
  6. If you choose to “Return to campus”, you can access a number of dedicated **Learning Spaces (Table A5)** equipped with WiFi access and made available in both Sungai Long Campus and Kampar Campus during weekdays throughout the 14 study weeks (not available on Saturday / Sunday / public holidays). At these Learning Spaces, you can use your own device to attend OTL lecture / tutorial / practical classes at your convenience, to conduct self-study or use them as waiting place in between classes that are conducted via physical mode and OTL mode. **Table A5 shows a list of Learning Spaces available for use on campus in May 2021 Trimester.**
  7. Faculty / Foundation Centre may conduct remedial classes for certain courses with practical / laboratory sessions and such arrangements shall be announced by the relevant Faculty / Centre in due course.
  8. Students who plan to register for **industrial training / clinical training** in May 2021 Trimester and who will be attached to the company / institution outside the University, need NOT return to campus. Please follow the instructions of your Faculty for industrial training / clinical training arrangements.
  9. For **FMHS students**, due to the need of clinical placement and training, please refer to the faculty for further information and arrangements.
  10. For **International students**, please contact the Department of International Student Services (DISS) if you need further information or have further queries.

11. For **students of Postgraduate Programmes by research mode**, you can continue your R&D activities on campus as planned by following the latest MOHE instructions, physical distancing and safety SOPs.
12. For **Final year students who are doing final year projects**, you can return to campus to use the relevant campus facilities, and meet with your Project Supervisors by appointment for face-to-face consultation in addition to online consultation. Physical distancing and safety SOPs must be followed.

### **B. Online Course Pre-registration and Confirmation of Academic Study Mode in May 2021 Trimester**

1. Upon completion of the above Academic Study Mode Survey, all existing students of Foundation and Undergraduate Programmes shall complete the Course Pre-registration and Confirmation of Academic Study Mode online at <https://unitreg.utar.edu.my/>, starting from **8 April 2021** according to the staggered schedule as follows:
  - (i) **Foundation Programmes: 21 April to 23 April 2021**
  - (ii) **Undergraduate Programmes: 8 April to 23 April 2021**

Please refer to **Table B1** for the details of the staggered timetable allocated to the programmes of Faculty / Institute / Centre for May 2021 Trimester. 2. Please take note that all existing students of each academic programme is given a specific time period according to the schedules in **Table C1** to complete the following:
  - (i) **Pre-registration of Courses and Course Delivery Method**

For course pre-registration, students (except for new students of May 2021 intake) need to pre-register for courses to be taken in May 2021 Trimester by choosing the lecture groups (**via OTL mode only**) and the appropriate tutorial / practical groups (**via Physical or OTL mode**), as allotted by the respective Faculty / Centre for the registered courses, where applicable.

- (ii) **Confirmation of Academic Study Mode**

During course pre-registration, all existing students must confirm your selection whether or not to return to campus to attend classes via Physical or OTL course delivery method in May 2021 Trimester. **Your selection shall be automatically approved upon clicking the submission button.**

After course pre-registration, if you wish to change your decision on the academic study mode / course delivery method selected due to unforeseen reasons, please contact your Faculty / Institute / Centre General Office, and apply to your Faculty Dean / Centre Director for approval, subject to the availability of the classes, before the commencement of May 2021

Trimester. If necessary, you may also change the course lecture / tutorial / practical groups throughout the Add and Drop Period of May 2021 Trimester.

3. For new students of May 2021 intake, you are required to complete the confirmation of your preferred **Academic Study Mode** (Come to Campus; or Not to Come to Campus) and **Course Delivery Method** (Physical mode / Online Teaching and Learning mode) via <https://unitreg.utar.edu.my/StudyConfirmMay>. After you have confirmed your Academic Study Mode and Course Delivery Method, your Faculty / Institute / Centre will pre-assign the course lecture, tutorial / practical groups of all your registered courses. Please check your timetable in the UTAR portal system for the details of assigned lecture / tutorial / practical groups and contact your Faculty / Institute / Centre general office if you need further clarification.

Please note that the conduct of all essential physical hands-on classes and activities in the University campuses or the use of campus infrastructures and facilities, where relevant, will also follow all the health and safety SOPs as per MOHE and the relevant authorities, as well as the physical distancing SOPs issued by the University.

Any changes / updates to the above arrangements will be announced from time to time, in accordance to the latest directives from MOHE, professional bodies and relevant authorities.
